Ages 15 + (Grade 10 and up)


Over this 2 year program campers will develop a solid understanding of God's truth for their lives. CILTs learn leadership skills for use at camp and in their home communities

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Q: What is the camper to staff ratio?**
A: Small cabin groups allow for lots of individualized attention. Qualified and trained leaders supervise each area in camp. All staff are there to ensure your child has a positive camping experience. The ratio is almost 2 to 1!
- Q: Is There a Health Care Worker on site?**
A: The health and safety of your child at our camp is our primary concern. There is a qualified health care worker on-site 24 hours a day and a doctor on call if needed
- Q: When do we drop off and pick up our child?**
A: Arrival is Sunday 2:30-3:30 pm. Pick Up is Friday between 2:00-3:00 pm.
- Q: Where do I go from here?**
A: Complete the registration form and submit on line, mail or fax it along with payment to the Barrie office. Upon receipt of your registration and payment, an information package will be sent to you with further details and confirmation of registration
- Q: My child has food allergies or special dietary needs; will they be able to attend?**
A: Camp Cherith's kitchen staff prepare three meals per day in accordance with the Canada Food Guide. A vegetarian option is offered with every meal. Other dietary needs will only be accommodated on an individual basis if possible. Camp Cherith is a nut sensitive environment.
